

SECTION 23
VILLAGE OF MAYVILLE SIDEWALK ORDINANCE
(Adopted – November 1st, 2017)

Sec. 23-1. Definitions.

The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation of this Ordinance:

- a. "Sidewalk" shall mean the portion of the street right-of-way designed for pedestrian travel.
- b. "Director" shall mean the Director of Public Works.

Sec. 23-2. Specifications and Permits

No person shall construct, rebuild or repair any sidewalk except in accordance with the line, grade, slope and specifications established for such sidewalk, nor without first obtaining a written permit and specifications from the Director.

Sec. 23-3. Line and Grade Stakes

The Director shall furnish line and grade stakes as may be necessary for proper control of the work, but this shall not relieve the owner of responsibility for making careful and accurate measurements in constructing the work to the lines furnished by the Director. Where it is necessary to replace engineer's stakes disturbed or destroyed without fault on the part of the Village, or its employees, a charge of one (\$1.00) dollar per stake shall be paid.

Sec. 23-4. Sidewalk Specifications.

Sidewalks shall be constructed in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Director, copies of which shall be available to the public.

Sec. 23-5. Permit Revocation.

The Director may issue a stop order to any permittee holding a permit issued under the terms of this Chapter for failure to comply with this ordinance, or the rules, regulations, plans and specifications established for the construction, rebuilding or repair of any sidewalk, and the issuance of such stop order shall be effective until the next regular meeting of the Village Council, and if confirmed by the Council, at its next regular meeting, such stop order shall be permanent, and shall constitute a revocation of the permit.

Sec. 23-6. Construction by Village.

If the owner of any lot or premises shall fail to build any particular sidewalk as described in said notice, and within the time and in the manner required thereby, the Village Council is hereby authorized and required, immediately after the expiration of the time limited for the construction or rebuilding by the owner, to cause such sidewalk to be constructed and the expense thereof shall be charged to such premises and the owner shall pay bill or it will be put on their tax roll as an assessment.

Sec. 23-7. Sidewalk Maintenance.

No person shall permit any sidewalk which adjoins property owned by him to fall into a state of disrepair or to be unsafe.
