Staffing – a) President Valentine introduced Police Officer Louis “Louie” Cook as a candidate for the Chief of Police position, due to the recent resignation of Police Chief Tony Coln. b) Louie shared his personal and professional background, which included his recent retirement from the Flushing Township Police Department as well as his history with Mayville and Kingston Police Department. c) President Valentine and the Council shared it is their vision for the role of Police Chief in Mayville and Kingston. The Council and Officer Cook came to an accord regarding expectations and pay.

Village Chief of Police Position – Moved by Charette, and supported by Barkowska to hire Louis Cook as the Chief of Police in the amount of \$22/hour, 32 hours per week, not to exceed 40 hours per week, with no Comp hours.
