**President Updates -**

- a) **CDBG Grant Progress** - Had a final engineering meeting with Spicer Group last week. Goes to MSF (Michigan Strategic Fund) on September 22,2020
- b) **Blue Water Community Action Water Assistance Program \ Water - Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (WCARE) Policy** - The purpose of the program is to create residential utility relief to provide direct payment for water and wastewater utilities to help households retain water service to help mitigate the spread of Covid-19. To be eligible for assistance, a residential water service customer must be identified through an electronic match via MDHHS as receiving food assistance program (FAP) benefits and must have accumulated new arrearages or fees after March 1, 2020. Arrearages prior to March 1, 2020 are not eligible. Residents do NOT apply for this program! Participation is determined by the utility provider. More info to come.
- c) **Sewer and Lagoon Project Updates** - Have a final engineering meeting with Spicer Group next week. Tentatively planning to have an Informational meeting in October to **one last time discuss the IMPORTANCE of the Public Health & Safety Hazards caused by the Lagoon liner failure and the absolute NEED of the Sewer\Lagoon Project.** President Valentine read a portion of a letter addressed to the past Village President Clare Fryers, dated 2006 from DEQ. Stating that the Lagoons were leaking into the Groundwater!
