AMENDMENT TO VILLAGE OF MAYVILLE WATER ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to Amend the Village of Mayville Water Ordinance

The Village of Mayville hereby ordains:

**Section 1.** The Village of Mayville Water Ordinance, Section 70-31 *et seq.*, of the Village of Mayville Code of Ordinances (Village of Mayville Water Ordinance), is amended as follows:

- A. All Fees for water service, demand, usage, connection, ready-to-serve, or other similar matters shall be established by the Village Council by Resolution. The Village Council may adopt a Resolution amending one or more of these fees from time to time as the Village Council deems appropriate. The fees established by the Village Council for the aforesaid purposes are within the sole discretion of the Village Council.
- B. Any and all past-due water bills (which include but are not limited to fees, fines, penalties and costs) (hereinafter "fees") (related to water service, demand, usage, connection, ready-to-serve, or other similar matters) shall be tendered by the Village of Mayville to the County of Tuscola on or before May 15 of each calendar year. Once tendered to the County of Tuscola, the fees shall be added to the property taxes for the real property at which water service was provided. Past-due fees shall be treated as and collected in the same manner as past-due property taxes and property-tax liens under the General Property Tax Act, Act 206 of 1893, MCL 211.1 *et seq.*

**Section 2. Ratification and Confirmation.** The remaining provisions of the Village of Mayville Water Ordinance are hereby ratified and confirmed.

**Section 3. Severability.** The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is hereafter declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

**Section 4. Repeal.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect on the date of its publication, which shall occur on April 12, 2023.

**Section 6. Publication.** The Village Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law.

Made and passed by the Village of Mayville, County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, at a special meeting on April 5, 2023, and ordered to be given publication in the manner prescribed by law.
